

Terms and Conditions of Associate Membership of Common Room

Associate Membership of Reuben Common Room is not, in itself, a formal academic affiliation to Reuben College or the University of Oxford. Associate Membership of the Common Room is distinct from Membership of College. As such, Associate Common Room Members may not make reference to their membership or use the name, crest or branding of Reuben College in external publications or on other media/social media (including websites) without the express permission of Reuben College. Associate Members of Common Room who are found to be in breach of these rules may have their membership terminated with immediate effect.

- A. Membership (through Categories A & C only) may be renewed subject to eligibility requirements which include remaining in good standing with the College and ensuring that any and all membership charges are paid on or before the due date.
- B. Membership will confer the right to book onto advertised Reuben College dinners (for example formal halls and Tuesday night dinners also known as 'DwD') and events (such as seminars, talks and conferences).
- C. Members, other than those in their first [two] years of membership, are required to pay a small annual fee (subject to annual review) towards the costs of administration.
- D. Membership will not confer with it University membership, a University card, College email address.
- E. Access within the College is limited to the ground floor and the Dining Hall.
- F. Lunch provisions served in the dining hall will be subject to non-Reuben member rates.
- G. The rules governing disciplinary procedures for Associate Members of Common Room are the same as for college members, and can be found in the College regulations which are available on the College website.
- H. Membership may be withdrawn at any time if the conduct of a member is injurious to the reputation of the College, and/or is deemed to have violated the Colleges' regulations and policies, or if the associate Member ceases to fulfil any criterion of eligibility for membership.
- I. The College reserves its right to reduce the numbers of Associate Members of Common Room at any time and for any reason through the suspension of any period of automatic renewal. The College also reserves its right to cancel an individual's membership at any time and for any reason.
